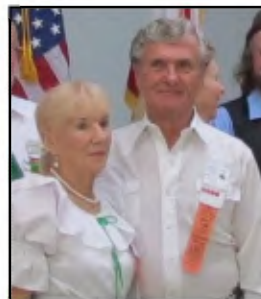
Saturday's hall was a wreck when we arrived on Thursday but was usable on Saturday AM for Breakfast.
