We hope to see many of you at our scheduled campouts. For those of you coming, you can either call the resort and give them your details, or just to let us know (we need to know ASAP for Zachary Taylor in November) that your coming and we'll send the resort a list of who, what type of rig, site requirements, etc. So far, none of the resorts except Sunshine in Lake Placid has required a deposit per attendee.

For those of you coming to the Camporee in October, just a little more information. The Camporee starts officially on Thursday, October 16th and runs through Sunday, October 19th. The Camporee rally rate is \$25 per night and is good for two days before and two days after if you want to extend your stay. The Strawberry Travelers will be camping and dancing there on October 10th and 11th and also have an agreed rally rate of \$25 per day. If you care to attend their camp/dance weekend, you can do so by letting them know (Carolyn Dees @ 813-610-7573) and Blueberry Hill at the above phone number. You will not have to change sites if you stay Sunday, Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday in between the two events. The extra days are available at Passport America rate (not sure what that is). Several of us are choosing to do that and make a small vacation out of it with lots of

dancing.

We also need to elaborate on our January campout. Because we were not able to come up with anything else, we chose Sunshine RV Resort in Lake Wales because our caller, Sonny McCartney, has a call date there for the Pine Ridge Promenaders on Thursday, January 8. Anyone interested in going on Thursday can then dance with them. The RoadRunners can have our dance on Friday and Saturday and hope to have many of the Pine Ridge folks dance with us. That will provide us with three nights of dancing. The rate is a little steep, but our only alternative for January. The Sunshine Resort has reserved up to 15 sites for us, but requires a \$25 non-refundable deposit per site to be paid before December 26th, 2014. Please consider that this weekend could provide some significant income in the way of nonmember dancers on Friday and Saturday...
