Detailed instructions to get you to the campground are below. We are planning to have a few directional signs out also to help everyone find it.

From I-95, Exit 201

1. Go West on Hwy 520, (W. King St.) to Tucker Ln. (About 0.15 mile)
2. Turn South on to Tucker Ln. (It is between McDonalds & the Chevron)
3. Follow Tucker Ln. for 0.5 mile (Watch for Square Dance sign, second right
4. turn past Central Life Church)

5. Turn right off Tucker Ln and go about 130 feet to Flamingo Rd /turn left
6. Follow Flamingo Rd. to Joy RV entrance 0.1 mile
